We are happy to announce that we are only about six weeks from having our pipe organ back and better than ever! Monday, Patrick Murphy & Associates will begin the meticulous installation in the church. Piece by piece, over 1000 pipes and the many thousands of other parts will be moved from the workshop and reassembled in our loft.

After Easter, Patrick and his team will return to voice & tune each pipe individually until perfectly suited for our church's worship space and acoustics. When the "voicing" is complete, the project is finished!

IMPORTANT!

Installation will begin Monday, March 4.

During this time the church will be an active work zone and will be closed to visitors Monday—Friday.

Stations of the Cross and weekend masses will be in church as usual, but the choir loft will be inaccessible.

Daily Mass will be celebrated in the school auditorium for approximately two weeks.
